Overview of Job Responsibilities

- Assist the classroom teacher in establishing procedures, standards, and rules for positive and effective classroom management; be consistent with classroom rules and their implementation

- Employ a variety of instructional aids, methods, and materials that will provide for creative teaching to reach the spiritual, mental, physical, social, and emotional aspects of each child
